

Dear Parish Family:

Hope you are all doing well. Two weeks ago, our church experienced some sort of vandalism by someone who is unknown. After a Friday Morning Mass, myself and Kevin noticed that a stain glass widow in the church shattered together with the outside plain glass and noticed a big rock which still sits there. We called the insurance company to report it and to see if they would cover the cost of replacing it. But they asked us to file a police complaint and get a report from them. And so we called the Purcell Police Personal and they came and looked at it and had the news item published in the face book I believe. And last Wednesday morning, I noticed the news channel 4 together with the Police detective were here to air what had happened and report to the community and were requesting for any clues or the culprits to come forward to accept the mistake. That is how our church was reported in the news channel and the damage that has been done to the church stain glass window. We have replaced the outside plain glass and have got some estimates to replace or repair the stain glass window and are waiting for the approval of the insurance company.

Hence, I want to update you all what had actually happened so that you are aware. However, we have installed some cameras around the church as a precautionary measure.

Querida familia parroquial:

Espero que estén todos bien. Hace dos semanas, nuestra iglesia experimentó algún tipo de vandalismo por parte de un desconocido. Después de una misa del viernes por la mañana, Kevin y yo notamos que una ventana vitral de la iglesia estaba quebrada y notamos una gran roca que todavía está allí. Llamamos a la compañía de seguros para informarles y ver si cubrirían el costo de reemplazarlo. Pero nos pidieron que presentáramos una denuncia policial y que obtuviéramos un informe. Y entonces llamamos al personal de la policía de Purcell y ellos vinieron, lo miraron e hicieron que la noticia se publicara en Facebook, creo. Y el miércoles pasado por la mañana, noté que el canal de noticias 4 junto con el detective de la Policía estaban aquí para reportar lo sucedido e informar a la comunidad y estaban solicitando pistas o que los culpables se presentaran para aceptar el error. Así fue como nuestra iglesia fue trasmitida en un reporte del canal de noticias y el daño que se le ha hecho a la ventana de la iglesia. Hemos reemplazado el vidrio liso exterior y tenemos algunos presupuestos para reemplazar o reparar la ventana vitral y estamos esperando la aprobación de la compañía de seguros.

Por lo tanto, quiero actualizarles todo lo que realmente sucedió para que estén al tanto. Sin embargo, hemos instalado algunas cámaras alrededor de la iglesia como medida de precaución.

Religious Education will begin Sunday, September 13th - Pre-K thru 6th Grade and Wednesday September 16th - 7th thru 8th Grade and First and Second year Confirmation Prep.

R. E. INFORMATION FROM FR. JOHN PETER

This week I want to write to all about the Religious Education Program for our children. Very soon we are going to begin the RE classes with all the necessary precautions in place in the light of Covid-19. We are inviting the parents to fill in the Registration forms that are available at the back of the church, or on line in our parish website, or in the face book etc. Please parents take time to fill out the registration forms and drop them at the parish office. The last date is September 4th and the classes begin from September 13th and 16th onwards. The Catechism of the Catholic Church say that:

"Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child's earliest years. This already happens when family members help one another to grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Family catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God. The parish is the Eucharistic community and the heart of the liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents." (CCC 2226)

As parents when you baptize your baby, you are taking the responsibility in helping the child to grow in the Christian faith. Being a parent is not an easy job in today's society. You have to deal with so many challenges with your children and so much of patience is needed. However as parents you are responsible for the moral and faith formation of our children. You are not meant merely to drive them to the Sunday classes and drop them at the church for the sacraments of initiation -- Baptism, Communion and Confirmation and the catechists who instruct their children on basic doctrine. However, we know that nothing and no one can replace the influence of the example of a parent on the spiritual life of a child. Hence I would earnestly urge every parent who has children to encourage your children to participate in the RE Programs and assist in the spiritual growth of your children. I am really amazed at the way parents in our parish bring their children for the Sunday Mass and participate as a whole family. It reminds me of my childhood days.
